Meeting Minutes
Penn State–York
Monday March 29, 2010

- Treasures Report was handed out.
 - Team treasurer's need to fill out the correct coaches vouchers. The correct voucher can be found on the FC York web-site.

- CPYSL
 - April 7th is the last meeting our rep, John Marrs, will be attending.
 - FC York may not need to attend the June 2nd meeting as we will not have any teams in the league in the fall.

- PAGS
 - Player/Coaches passes do not need to be signed this year.
 - There will be stricter rules for reassigning games due to weather. Games must be cancelled 3 hours prior to game time. Tim Holden is the only person who will be contacting PAGS.
 - No playoffs for U9, U10, & U11.
 - On line team application period is April 1–June 13th
 - If a game date needs to be changed, not due to weather, it must be applied for 10 days in advance or additional fees will be applied.
 - Only PAGS delegate may apply for a game change via the online form. This person is Heather Brunell.
 - New by-law: U9, U10 & U11 – players will be permitted to play with any team in their club at a higher age or division in addition to their main team. No player can play more than 2 PAGS games per day & 3 PAGS games in a weekend.
 - New by-law: The use of up to 5 secondary players in age divisions U15–U19 will be allowed instead of the old limit of 3.
 - New by-law: After up to 3 games in any season, PAGS can reassign misplaced teams (moving them up or down a division).
 - PAGS will attempt to limit the amount of travel for U9 & U10.
 - Renaming of Divisions. PAGS will name all divisions numerically beginning with Division 1 being the highest division.
 - Next PAGS meeting May 17.

- DOC
 - Boys side have (1) coaching position open.
 - Mark Ludwig wants the boys' teams to e-mail them their State Cup scores.

- February meeting minutes were approved.

 - The calendar is up to date for April/May.
